DIFFERENTIAL REINFORCEMENT SYSTEM

1. Negative/Provocative Verbalizations

Response: Override (ignore the comment and proceed with the lesson; do not change or shift teacher behavior)

2. Blurt-Outs/Off Topic

Response: Neutral Acknowledgement (attend briefly to the comment, using phrases such as, "I see," "oh", "you did?" "uh huh" "okay" etc.)

3. Blurt-Outs/On Topic

Response: *Praise* (acknowledge and show interest/approval, using phrases such as, "interesting point" "that's right!" "exactly")

4. Hand Raised/On Topic

Response: a) if the answer is correct, apply high praise, using words of admiration such as, "brilliant point" "just what we're looking for"

b) if the answer is incorrect, adjust the answer so that praise can be applied; e.g. "you're doing some good thinking here...now (lead the answer)" or "you're on track...now (lead the answer)" or "good thinking... let's take it further.."
